Village of Benson Board of Trustees Meeting.

Called to order by Mayor Chris Mullins

Roll Call- All present

Nate Waldschmidt made motion to approve minutes, seconded by Roger Nenne.

Morgan Koehler presented the financial report- everything ok.

Discussed the amount of \$4,350.00 (will not exceed) for the yearly audit by Hopkins and associates. Chris called for a motion. Roger Nenne made motion and was seconded by Neil Heineke to approve amount for next fiscal year.

The NUN (Economic Statement of Interest) sheets were filled out by all and will be taken to Woodford County to be filed.

Chris presented the board with a Solar Energy Assessment permit paper. This would and will be presented to homeowners as a free building permit for solar power put on their residence. This does not cover solar farms or solar panels in yards. Board agreed to issue this non fee type of building permit to new and existing residential solar power usage in the village.

Discussed the garbage dumpster at the American Legion. K&T Disposal brought to Chris Mullins a complaint regarding that this dumpster is free. It seems to be the catch all for the town residents. It usually has a lot of garbage in it.

Discussed the use of some of the RBI money be used for an access for clean out purposes of 4-5 blocks of Main Street.

Neil Heineke asked if he could delete old minutes (2016-2020) on the website. Board agreed that would be alright.
