Discussed replacing damaged flag pole at the park. Pole was damaged during recent ice storm.

Tree trimmers will be in town this week to finish cleanup of storm damaged limbs.

Chris reported that the fire hydrant at the end of Clayton Street has been fixed.

Discussed water standing at intersection of Front and Mary Streets. It doesn't appear to be a water main leak at this time, just storm water runoff.

Chris discussed available grants for the Village. Possible uses may include an emergency texting service, generator for the town hall and possibly school. Dan suggested finding a grant writer to help with this.

Discussed a few residents who have had complaints about rust in water. We may need to flush a few hydrants to see if it will help.

Discussed drainage problem along Northridge Drive both along the county road and behind the houses. Chris suggested asking Illinois Rural Water if they could assist with a survey.

Dan reported that the washout area at the intersection of Clayton and Rt. 116 is getting worse.
