This meeting was conducted virtual- Due to COVID-19 Virus.

Called to order by Mayor Chris Mullins

Chris met with Amigoni Construction in regards to the Lutheran Church parsonage. Will leave the parsonage house on existing shutoff between the house and the church. New shut off for the church will be installed with the fee of \$500 the church will pay. Amigoni Construction will have to bore under the street to put new shutoff in.

Chris mentioned 4 alleys in town that need repaired, grating and more gravel.

Chris will contact Beyer Tree Service to have them look and price some trees that need trimmed, limbs cut and removed from the ice storm damage.

Chris got a price (estimate \$14,000 +change) from Dan Steffen for oil and chipping for roads. Mike Amigoni for camera work on some drains. Midstate Asphalt for spray patching of the streets. Will use RBI money.

The hanging furnace (75,000BTU) in the shed has stopped working. Got a price from CIA of \$2,360 for a 90,000BTU unit. Motion was made by Nate Waldschmidt and seconded by Roger Nenne.

Discussed that we have 16 bad water meters that need replaced. We only have 11 available. Will discuss with Eric Gerdes.
