Called to order by Mayor Chris Mullins

Roll Call-Josh Brown absent

Nate Waldschmidt made motion to approve minutes, seconded by Neil Waldschmidt.

Neil Heineke made motion to approve bills, seconded by Roger Nenne.

Nate Waldschmidt made motion to approve treasurer report, seconded by Roger Nenne.

Murray Manley was present in regards to more information on a quote for the Tornado Siren for the Village. Neil Heineke reached out to Ragan Electronics in Washington. We received a quote of \$2,617.65 from the pictures that Neil had taken. Ragan Electronics will come over and look at the equipment in person. The cost could be different.

Chris will contact the fire department in regards to any changes or equipment needed, to have equipment installed inside and outside. Chris will contact Kent McCaless at ESDA and get more details on them setting the siren off.

Chris called for a motion to accept purchasing the new equipment for the siren. Roger Nenne made motion to accept, seconded by Nate Waldschmidt. All present board members agreed.

Discussed the concept of plugins for electric cars in Benson. The Board is wondering if the town really needs this.

Discussed the possibility of issuing a building permit for the Elevator for concrete work that is being done. We would issue one and then that would notify Woodford County of the improvements the elevator is making. Also discussed the possibility of having someone in town that would issue all the building permits. The fee that is charged would go to the person that issue the permits.
